

## Romance Languages and Literatures major worksheet

### General notes:

- Students must identify their first, second, and third languages and complete the worksheet below with the appropriate DUS. The DUS must carefully plan the course of study with the student. Each section must be signed by a DUS prior to approving the student's major request on WebStac.
- Students who place out of 307 for any reason, must replace the class with a 300-level elective in the appropriate language. That is, students who place out of 307 must meet the full credit count for the major.
- Students must complete a Writing Intensive course in either language I or II (Spanish 405, French 411 or 4131, or a designated 300- or 400-level Italian course).
- Students pursuing Italian 400-level courses must complete their coursework in Italian.
- All classes for the major must be taken for credit.
- The minimum grade for all classes is B-.
- Students must have a B average or better overall.
- In all cases, students must complete a total of 42 credits (18 in language I, 15 in language II, 9 in language III)
- Students may apply to count study-abroad courses only from programs approved by the Department of Romance Languages and Literatures. Major credit from study abroad will only be recognized for students who obtain authorization from both the relevant DUS and the major advisor prior to leaving for the program abroad. Failure to obtain these authorizations will result in a student's inability to count courses from abroad. Students may request credit at the 300- or 400-level depending on the program.
- Students must complete a capstone experience either by obtaining Latin honors through thesis or by completing a senior undergraduate seminar on junior or senior year with a grade of B+ or better.
- We encourage students to think about doing an honors thesis, perhaps combining two languages. The 6 units of 495 (honors) would be above and beyond the requirements listed below.
