

2017 SUMMER LANGUAGE INSTITUTE IN FRANCE—PARIS APPLICATION PROCEDURES

Your application for the 2017 Summer Language Institute in France (SLIF)-Paris program, Language Institute must include the following 5 items:

1. Admission form;
2. Waiver-of-responsibility signed by you and by a parent or legal guardian;

*Deliver the admission form and the signed waiver together to Prof. Vincent Jouane, Summer Language Institute in France—Paris, Department of Romance Languages and Literatures, 310 North Ridgley Hall (hand delivery) or Campus Box 1077, Washington University, One Brookings Drive, St. Louis, MO 63130-4899.

3. Transcript of previous work done at Washington University or, if you are a freshman, your high school transcript (you can obtain an unofficial WU transcript from Webstac);
4. Letter of recommendation from a professor, dean, advisor, or counselor who is able to comment on: a) your intellectual capabilities, b) your ability to live for three weeks in a close situation in a foreign country, and c) your ability to travel independently;

*Make arrangements to have your transcript and the letter of recommendation sent directly to: Prof. Vincent Jouane, Summer Language Institute in France—Paris, Dept. of Romance Languages and Literatures, Box 1077, Washington University, One Brookings Drive, St. Louis, MO 63130-4899.

5. Confidential evaluation form completed by your current French instructor

*Make arrangements with your instructor for her/him to leave the completed evaluation in Prof. Jouane's mailbox in the Department of Romance Languages and Literatures office, 310 N. Ridgley.

Prof. Jouane will contact you for an interview after he has received your completed dossier containing all 5 items listed above. Applications received by November 11, 2016 will have priority; other applications will be considered on a space-available basis.
